Type of the lesson: lesson discovery of new knowledge.

The aim of the lesson: The development of communicative competence.

Objectives of the lesson:

- teaching: to revise the vocabulary; to listen and understand a description about teens and their characters.

- developing: to develop listening comprehension; to develop creative activity, memory, imagination; to develop abilities of comparing and translation.

- up-bringing: to arouse pupils' interest in English; to arouse love to English lessons.

Планируемые результаты: повышать мотивацию к изучению английского языка, способность к самооценке на основе критерия успешности учебной деятельности; умение искать нужную информацию, фиксировать и обобщать ее; осуществлять самоконтроль и взаимоконтроль, самооценку в процессе коммуникативной деятельности на иностранном языке; умение ориентироваться в своей системе знаний, находить ответы на вопросы, используя учебник и информацию, полученную на уроке; высказывать свое мнение, обосновывать его в пределах изученной тематики и усвоенного лексико-грамматического материала; умение взаимодействовать с окружающими, совместно договариваться о правилах поведения и общения в парах.

Equipment: a poster «My family», slides, CD, computer, projector.

Procedure/ Steps:

I. Introduction. Greeting.

- Good morning, children. I'm glad to see you. Who is absent?

Open your books on p 10 and look at the title of the text. What does the title mean? Yes, today we'll have a talk about conversation with someone you don't know. By the way, how would you start a conversation with someone you don't know? As for me, I would introduce myself and ask the other person's name. What about you?

II. Warming up.

- I would like you to guess the riddle. It is about what we are going to talk at our lesson today. "We have friends,

They cannot play

And cannot see,

But they are good

To you and me". What are they?

- Right you are. Today we are going to talk about books, some famous writers and their characters and about the people who like to read. How do we call such people?
- So, the theme of our lesson is "Bookworms".

III. Motivation.

- -Are you fond of reading? Are you a bookworm? What kinds of books do you like to read?
- Well done!

Phonetic drills.

- My favourite free time activity is reading books. So I am a bookworm.
- I like reading historical novels.
- I prefer reading adventure stories.
